PARISH COUNCILLOR ALLOWANCES FINANCIAL YEAR 2007-8

The Independent Parish Remuneration Panel met on 15th March 2004 and decided to recommend a maximum basic allowance of £200 per annum and a maximum Chairman's basic allowance of £500 per annum. This is intended to cover the cost of incidental expenses associated with being a parish councillor or parish council chairman. Councillors can also claim travel and subsistence allowance for attending meetings, etc. of other bodies, where approved by the Parish Council, on the same scale as that for Borough Councillors. Copies of this report are available for inspection by members of the public on giving reasonable notice in writing to the Parish Clerk.

The Parish Council considered and accepted these recommendations but individual Councillors can elect to forgo the whole or part of any allowances he/she is entitled to claim over the year. The Parish Council keeps a record of payments in respect of parish basic allowance and travelling and subsistence allowances which will be available for inspection on reasonable notice and at no charge by any local government elector for the Kingsnorth area.
